Notice of Race

The Commodores Cup is scheduled for 3 and 4 May 2008, and is organised by Carsington Sailing Club on their water at Carsington, ASHBOURNE, Derbyshire, DE6 1SU, (tel.01629 540609). The Governing Bodies, conditions of entry, measurement procedures, changes to the Racing Rules and any restrictions etc are as set out in the current Carsington Sailing Club Ltd Open Race Meeting Sailing Instructions, this Notice of Race and any other attached appendices. All races shall be governed by the Rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing.

Registration

Registration will begin at 09.15hrs and will be located in the main clubhouse, where copies of the sailing instructions will be available.

Programme of Events

Three races will be held on Saturday. Three races will be held on Sunday.

Advertising

For the duration of this event advertising will be designated Category C.

Schedule of Races / Starting Times

Saturday warning signal times are 10.54 first race, then 13.24 second race with 3rd race run back to back. Sunday warning signal times are 10.54 first race, then 13.24 second race with 3rd race run back to back.

Starting sequence will be Fast, Cats, 1020+, Cruiser and Junior (6-3-Go) and every three minutes after.

Finishing Time Limit

Boats must finish within 15 minutes after the finish time of their class leading boat for their race to be valid.

Warning Flags / Class Flags

These will be as club championship format (ie numbered flags 1,2,3,4,5).

Number of Races to Count / Discards.

The anticipated number of races in meeting is 6.

Three races to count.

Any decision by the Protest Committee will be final and not subject to appeal

Prize Giving.

The number of prizes to be awarded will be First, Second and Third place for each of the following fleets; Junior, Single Hander, Cruiser, Fast, Medium and Catamaran.

COURSES

Courses to be sailed will be included in the race briefing or displayed on the committee boat.

THE FINISH

The “About to Finish Signal” will be indicated by a **Blue Flag** displayed on the **Committee Boat** mast with **2 sound signals** and **all boats** passing through the **Gate/Finish Line** after this signal (**irrespective of the number of laps completed**) will be **Finished**. **This modifies RRS “Race Signals”**.

RESULTS

Handicap Races will be decided by the “**Basic Average Lap time Method**” and the “**Time and Distance Scheme**”.

RACE BREIFING

Will be held at 10.00 am Saturday 3 May either in the Clubhouse, or on the Terrace

FACILITIES

Food will be available for purchase in the daytime from the galley in the clubhouse, during both days of the event. An evening meal and light entertainment will be available on Saturday, tickets can be purchased from the Galley. **Please purchase these in advance of the event to enable the galley to cater for your requirements.**

CAMPING

No camping or overnight parking is allowed on the club premises
