Notice of Race: Open Meeting Charity Regatta 2009.

This Charity Regatta is a two-day event scheduled for 12 and 13 Sept 2009, and is organised by Carsington Sailing Club on their water at Carsington, ASHBOURNE, Derbyshire, DE6 1SU, (tel.01629 540609). The Governing Bodies, conditions of entry, measurement procedures, changes to the Racing Rules and any restrictions etc will be as set out in the Sailing Instructions which will be available on the day, this Notice of Race and any other attached appendices. All races shall be governed by the Rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing.

Registration

A charity donation of £5 per person per day is suggested, as a minimum entrance fee for the meeting. Booking-in will begin at 9.00am each day and will be located in the clubhouse, where copies of the Open Meeting Sailing Instructions will be available.

Programme of Events

The event will comprise 6 races -3 to be held on Saturday and 3 on the Sunday – with 3 races to count overall.

Fleets to Sail:

The event will be held for the following handicap fleets.
Fast (PY 999 – 747 including Merlin Rocket), Catamarans (PY 912 – 652, SCHRS 1.320 – 0.950), Med (PY 1093 – 1000 inclusive), Slow & Junior (PY 1386 – 1078 plus Laser & Supernova), Cruisers, no longer than 24ft. (that can be launched by road trailer)

Schedule of Races / Starting Times

Saturday and Sunday warning signal times are: First race 10.54, other times TBA.
Starting order & sequence will be, Fast, Cats, Med, Slow/Junior, Cruisers, (6-3-Go) and every three minutes thereafter.

Fleet flags will be:-

- Fast, black “F” on a red background.
- Cats, black “C” on a pale blue background.
- Medium, black “M” on a yellow background.
- Slow / Junior, black “S&J” on a green background.
- Cruisers, black “K” on a white background.

Courses

Courses to be sailed will be displayed on the committee boat.

The Finish

The “About to Finish Signal” will be indicated by a Blue Flag displayed on the Committee Boat mast with 2 sound signals. Only boats who’s fleet flag is displayed with the finish flag, passing through the Gate/Finish Line after this signal will be Finished.
This modifies RRS “Race Signals”.

Results

Races will be scored by the Carsington SC “Basic Average Lap Method”.

Race Briefing

Will be held at 10.00 am on each day either in the Clubhouse, or on the Terrace.

Facilities

Food will be available for purchase in the daytime from the galley in the clubhouse, during both days of the event.

Camping

NO camping or overnight parking is allowed on the club premises.

Parking

If required daytime visitor parking will be available in the adjacent public car park.

Advertising

For the duration of this event advertising will be designated Category C.

Any decision by the Protest Committee will be final and not subject to appeal

Prize Giving

As this is a Charity event. The Charity Regatta will be a Trophy Event. Club Trophy's will be inscribed with names of the First. Second and Third places for each fleet and held on display at the club. The event results will be announced at the club after the last race on Sunday.
