The Governing Bodies, Racing Rules of Sailing, conditions of entry and any restrictions etc. are as set out in the current CSC Ltd Open Race Meeting Sailing instructions, this Notice of Race and any attached appendices will apply.

Registration Times

Registration 4 to 6 Weeks prior to the event is required to assist with planning and to avoid the late entry fee penalty. Entry at the event will be open from 10:00am on the Friday, located in the clubhouse. A pre-event fee of **£50** is required to be received by the 12th June latest. COURSES

The windward-leeward-triangle port hand type course will be sailed if possible with the triangle completed first using large orange inflatable buoys, however if the prevailing wind direction is difficult the race officer may change the course and use the club marks provided the change is posted in the clubhouse 45 minutes prior to racing together with flag 'L'. If club marks are used the course will be displayed on the committee boat.
